Introduction

The Israeli occupation forces launched a sudden attack on the Gaza Strip at 2:30 am on Tuesday, May 9, 2023, targeting several families while they were sleeping. The Palestinian Ministry of Health announced the martyrdom of 33, including 6 children and 3 women, 13 elderlies, and 64 were injured, including 13 children and women. A total of 140 residential units have become uninhabitable because of the aggression, including 103 that were destroyed, and 2800 residential units have been partially damaged.

Accordingly, we review a proposal for the reconstruction of the Gaza Strip

- Human Casualties

According to official Palestinian health sources in the Gaza Strip, the Israeli aggression in the area has resulted in significant human casualties. The following are the most notable statistics regarding aggression according to official sources:



Damage in the health sector

Hospitals in the Gaza Strip are suffering from a severe shortage of medicines, medical supplies, and fuel to operate effectively and perform necessary operations and duties. The Palestinian Ministry of Health has appealed for the urgent provision of medical devices, medical supplies, equipment, and medications. According to a report from the Palestinian Ministry of Health, urgent interventions have been announced as necessary to provide the speedy response required to save the lives of the wounded and injured.

The facilities and residential units

According to government statistics, **31** buildings in Gaza were directly targeted and as a result, **140** residential units were destroyed and deemed uninhabitable, including **103** units that were destroyed. In addition, **2800** residential units were partially damaged due to the ongoing Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip.

Economic Sector

The Head of the Government Media Office in Gaza announced during the presentation of the preliminary report on the overall damages and losses caused by the aggression, that estimating the losses in this sector is linked to the completion of identifying the shops and commercial establishments that were damaged due to the bombardment. It's worth noting that the losses related to the halt of economic activities were estimated at 40 million US dollars over the course of the five days of the aggression.

Furthermore, the Deputy Minister of Labor declared that the losses for daily wage workers were estimated at 2 million US dollars, affecting 157,600 workers who were adversely impacted and unable to work during the aggression, according to an initial estimate provided by the ministry, as detailed in the mentioned table.


- Agricultural Sector The value of losses in this sector amounted to 3 million US dollars, as follows
- 200 agricultural wells were directly damaged due to airstrikes, necessitating rehabilitation, refilling, and preparation to allow for replanting. Additionally, 10,000 meters of irrigation lines were affected in the agricultural areas that were subjected to bombardment across all regions of the sector.
- 600 dunums of cultivated land, encompassing vegetables and fruits, were impacted by the bombing operations, along with 150 dunums of covered agricultural greenhouses.
- Livestock farms including poultry, cattle, sheep, and beehives incurred losses amounting to 225,000 US dollars.
- Furthermore, the export of over 1100 tons of vegetables and fish came to a halt, along with a complete cessation of fishing activities.

■ Infrastructure Sector

The Head of Government Media clarified that the educational sector suffered damages to 7 schools and 9 kindergartens. Furthermore, the occupation targeted the infrastructure of the sector, with estimated losses amounting to 1 million US dollars. This includes the damage to 159 water pipelines, 173 sewage pipelines, and 304 electrical lines.
