

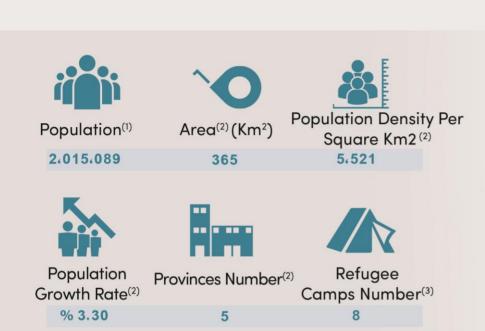


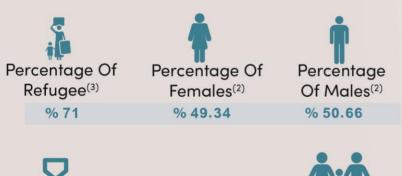

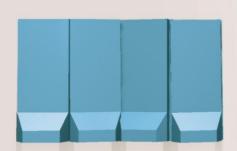

Upbringing and Development

Based on the recommendations of the International Forum in support of Gaza following the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip in the summer of 2014, and as a result of the continued suffering of the two million Palestinians living under siege since 2006, given the great importance the Palestinian issue is to the Turkish community - especially the Gaza Strip, and the support on an ongoing basis of humanitarian initiatives to alleviate this suffering, a group of experts and aid workers in Turkey gathered to establish the Gazzi Destek Association (GDD) in Istanbul to coordinate the efforts of all the donors to actively contribute to humanitarian meeting and development needs of the Gaza Strip.
