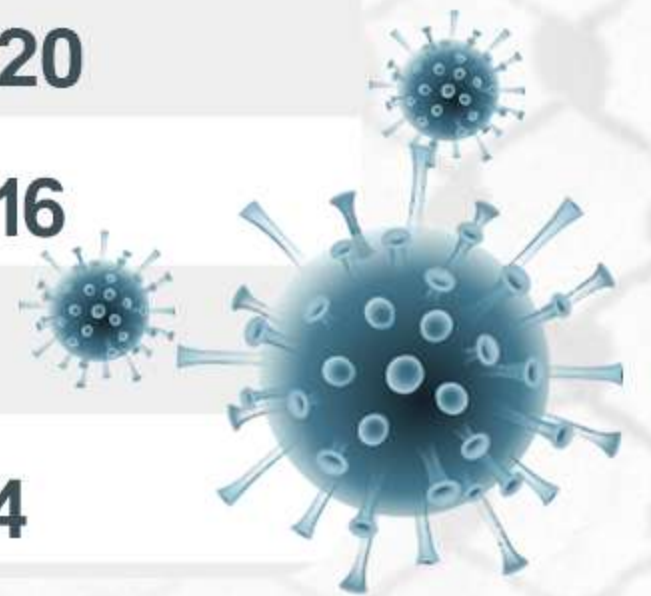

Most urgent interventions achieved

- In order to assist with the budget of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine refugees in 2023, the European Union has donated 82 million euros.
- The city of Huwara, which has been affected by settler attacks, has received half a million dollars in aid from Qatar.
- To provide financial assistance to refugees in Lebanon, UNRWA has initiated the distribution of cash aid in the amount of \$25 per person.
- The Syrian Red Crescent Society has provided food baskets to residents of the Daraa refugee camp.
- UNRWA has received a donation of US\$5.5 million from Japan to support its pro-

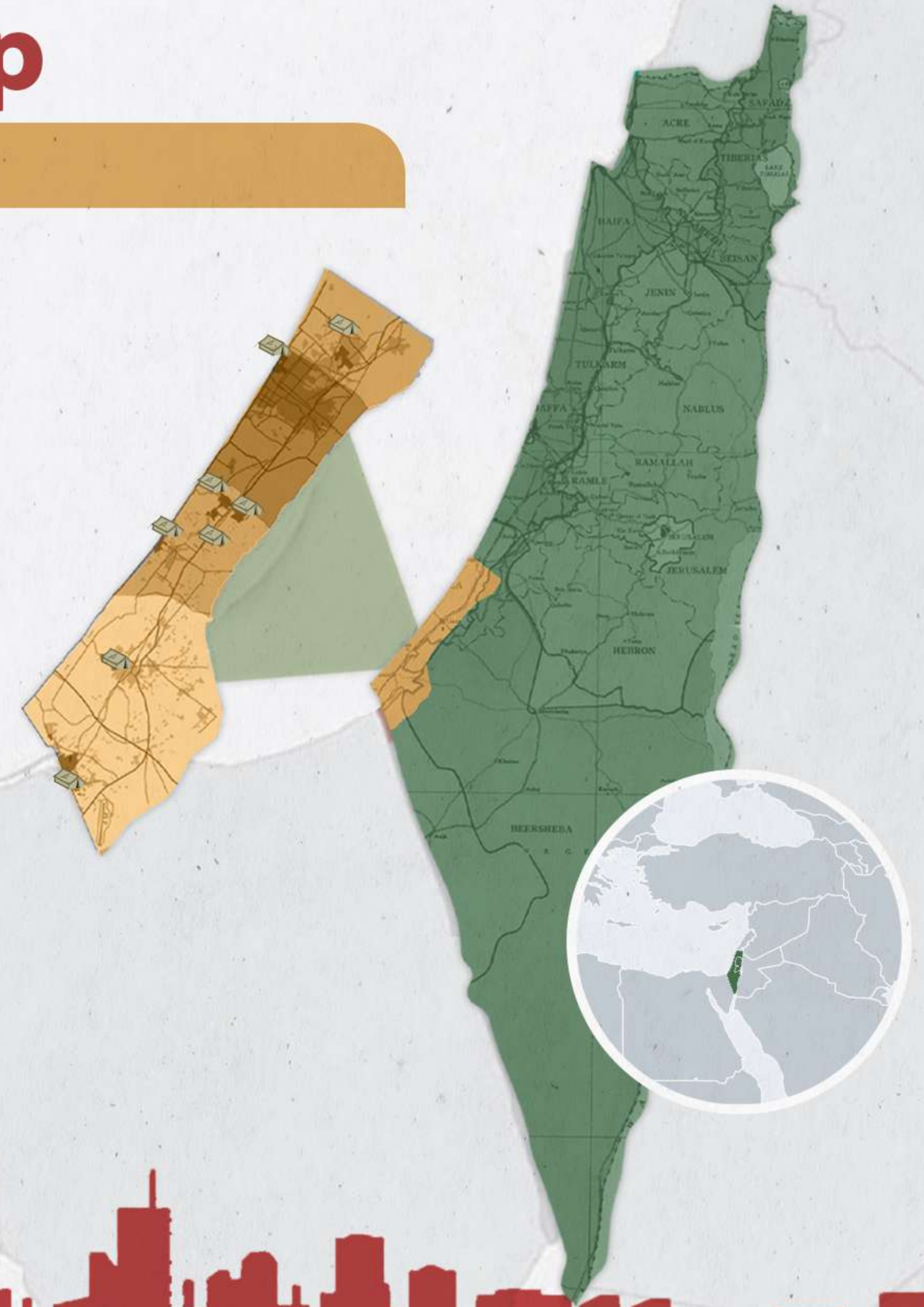

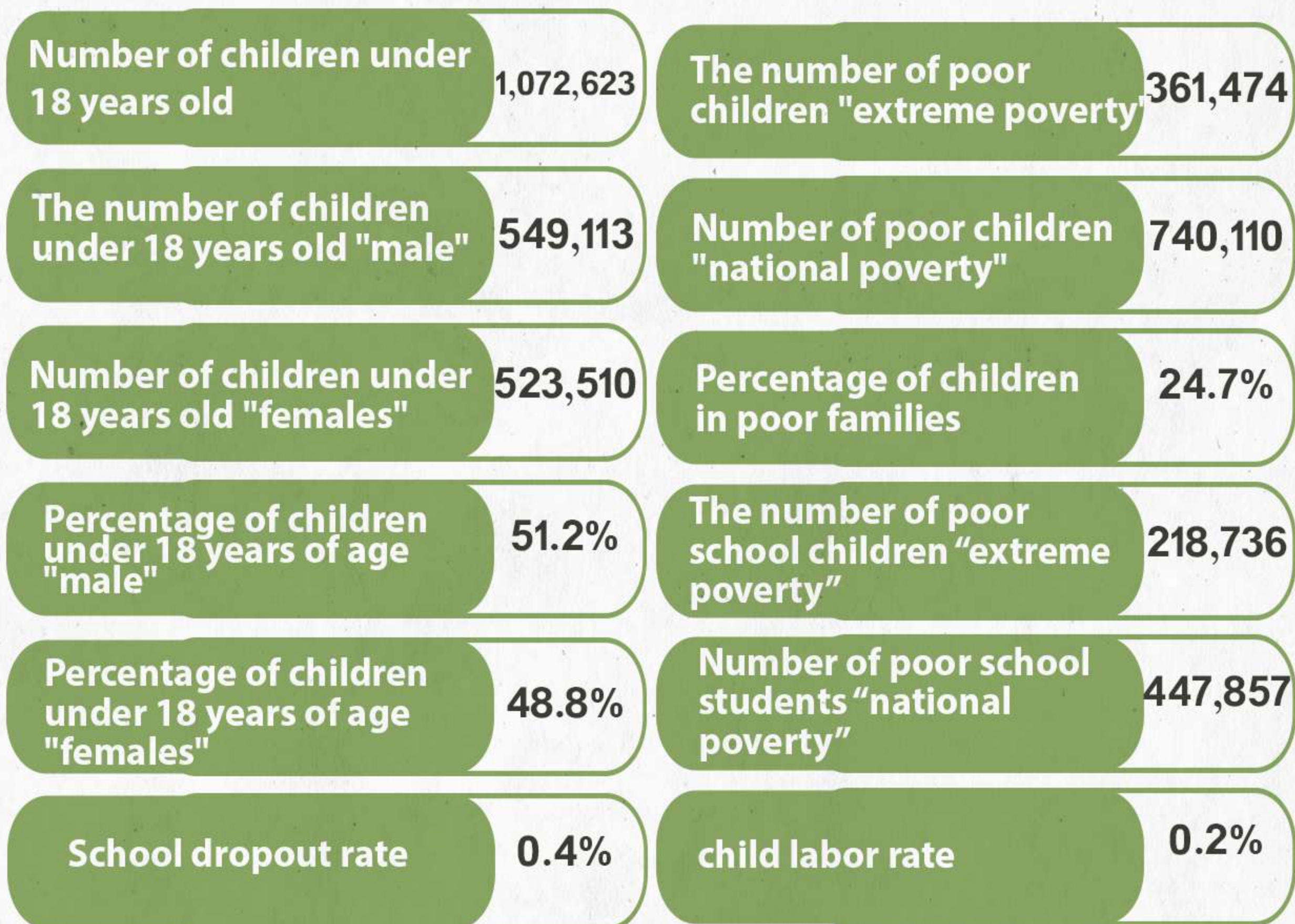

Most urgent interventions achieved

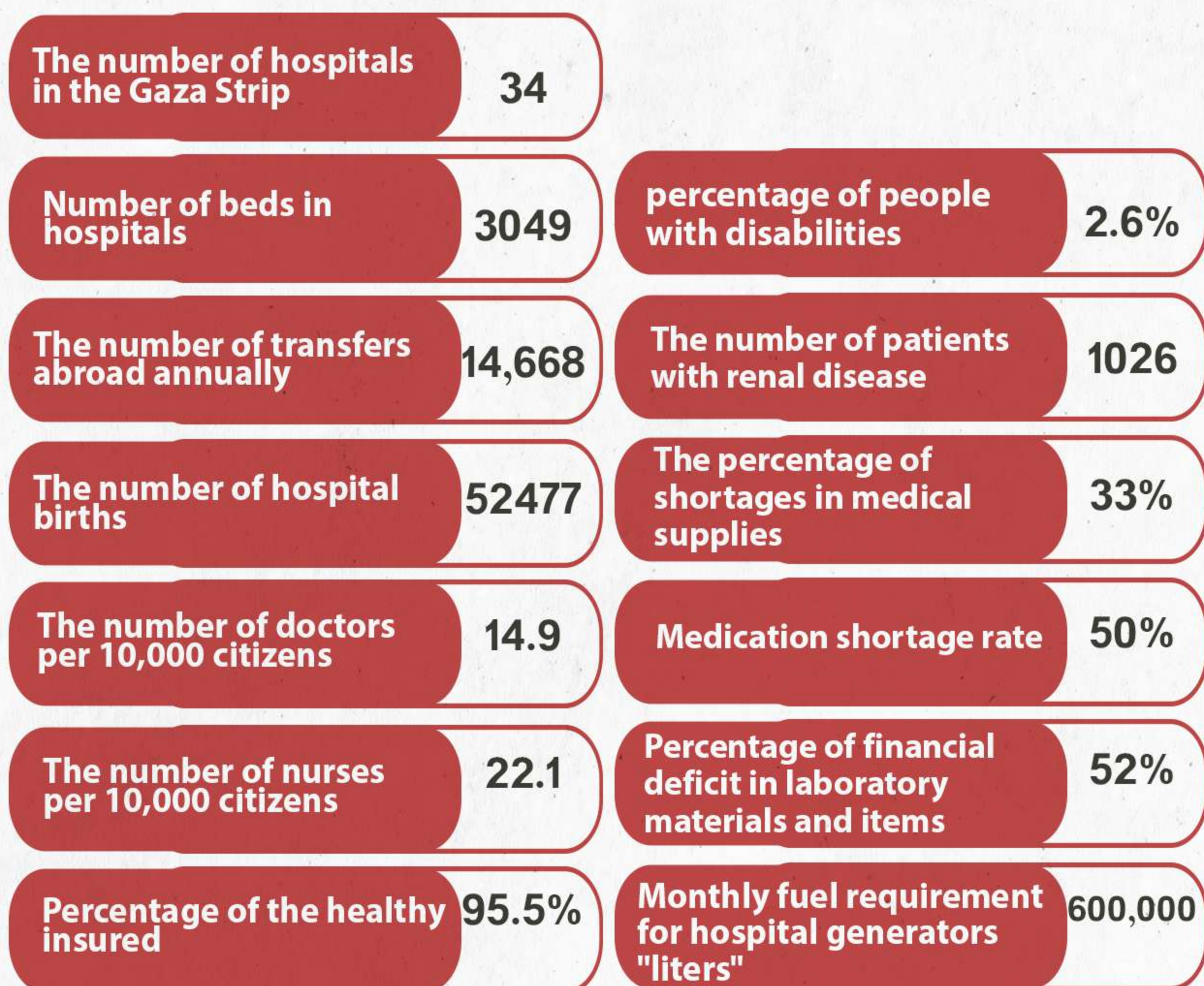
- 1. The Relief and Works Agency disbursed cash assistance to those affected by the August 2022 war, instead of rent, to 187 affected families.
- 2. The State of Qatar provided cash assistance to 100,000 poor families in the Gaza Strip.
- 3. The Sanabel Al-Khair Association has completed the files of 31 fines in prisons, at a value of 8,000 shekels
- 4. The Ministry of Awqaf provided food parcels to poor families, worth 204,000 shekels
