Definition of GDD

Gazze Destek Association (GDD) is a humanitarian foundation that was founded in 2014 in Istanbul to effectively contribute to meeting the humanitarian and developmental needs of the community in the Gaza Strip through coordinated humanitarian interventions in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and standards of integrity and transparency, humanitarian principles, and the relevant local and international laws. The scope of its interventions has expanded to include further areas of need around the world.

Definition of the report

This report covers the humanitarian situation of the Palestinians in Jerusalem, the West Bank, the Gaza Strip, the Diaspora (Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Libya, Yemen, Iraq and Sudan) and within the 48 territory, in order to shed light on their reality and the most prominent needs required in each region.

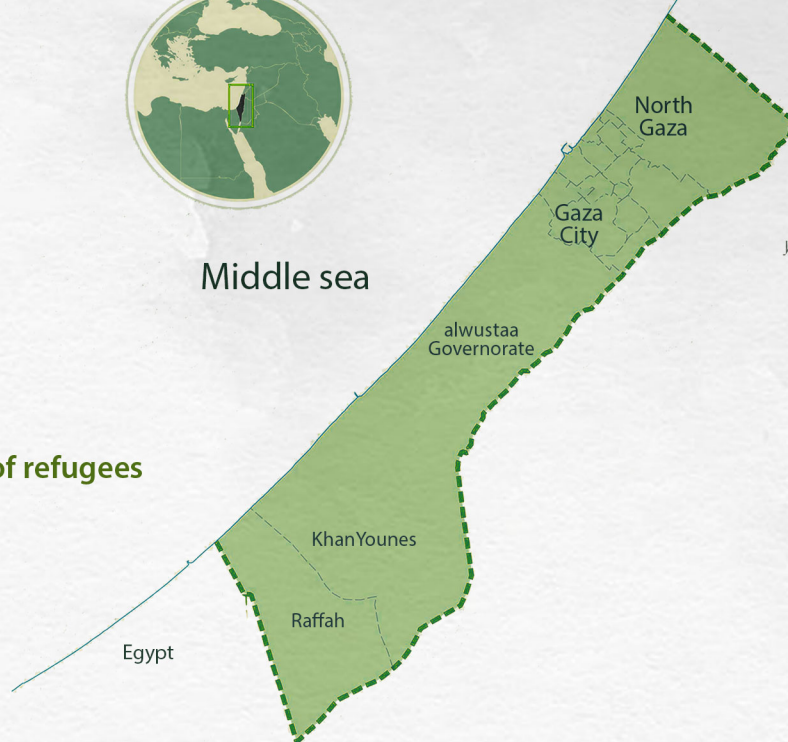

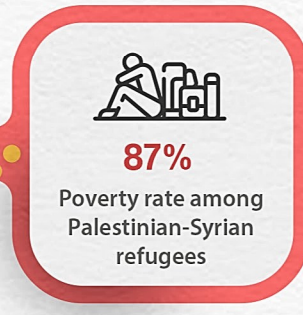
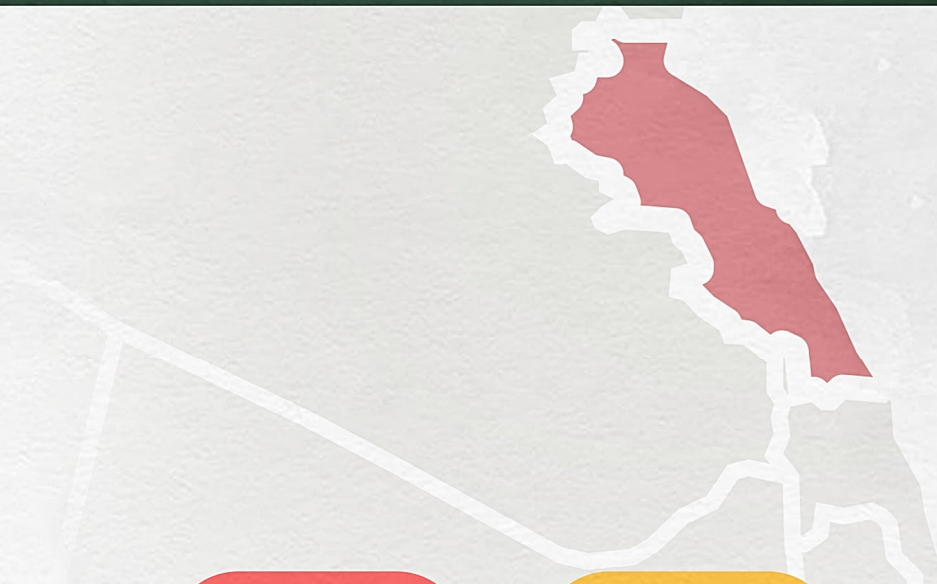


Jordan hosts nearly 2.5 million Palestinians, and although many of these refugees are housed in thirteen camps in Jordan, ten of them official and three unofficial, the majority live side by side with Jordanian citizens.

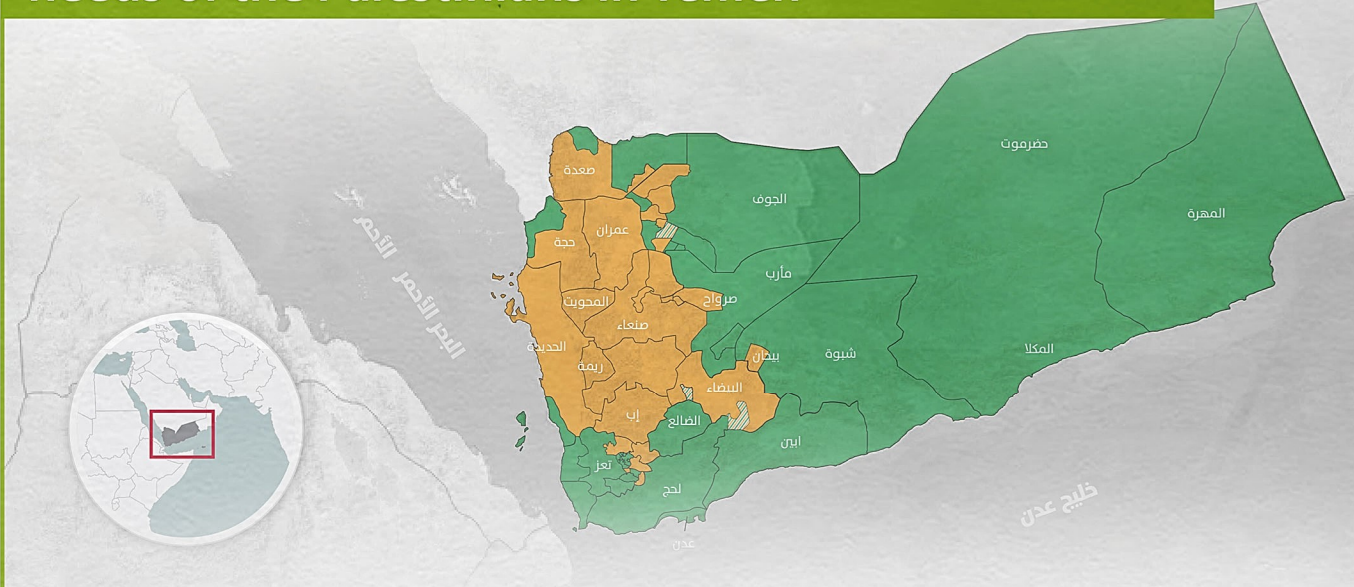
